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## Trend #2: Faster Lines = More Revenue

Speed is everything at a busy concession stand.

When venues go cashless (with reverse ATMs as a backup), the math is simple:

- **50–80% faster line movement**
- **\$4–\$7 increase in average spend per guest**
- **Reduced staff stress and training time**
- **30–50% lower transaction time at concessions**

Every second saved in line leads to more transactions—and more satisfied guests. Reverse ATMs support this by removing the cash bottleneck before it ever reaches the counter.
